Since 1950, WorldSkills is the global hub of skills excellence, which promotes vocational education and training for young people. Today, 86 Member countries and regions are invested to help young people change their lives and the fortune of their communities and societies through skills. Our Members represents two-thirds of the world's population with all their diversities, all united by the power of skills.

WorldSkills is also a network as its Competitions bring together Ministers, leaders of international organizations, top civil servants, heads of Chambers of Commerce, and academics. This global and strategic position allows WorldSkills to keep a big picture on how vocational skills are taking care of in the world and gives it a very powerful voice in the skills debate as well as the experience to lead discussions on a range of global challenges.

About WorldSkills Competitions

The WorldSkills Competition is the biggest vocational education and skills excellence event in the world.

Every 2 years, young people under the age of 23 from the 5 continents, national Champions in their skill, gather to compete for the chance to become the WorldSkills Champion in their respective skills. More than sixty different skills are represented, in several economic sectors. Traditional skills, but also environmental and future-oriented skills, are divided into 6 sectors: Creative Arts and Fashion, Manufacturing and Engineering Technology, Transportation and Logistics, Construction and Building Technology, Social and Personal Services and Information and Communication Technology.

Competitors must demonstrate technical abilities both individually and collectively to execute specific tasks in their skills. They are challenged to complete a test project or a series of projects within strict timeframes. The projects demand complex technical knowledge and capabilities that the young people are learning and mastering through their studies and workplace training.

WorldSkills Competition takes place over six days, beginning with an Opening Ceremony, followed by four days of competitions, and concluding with a Closing Ceremony where awards, including Gold, Silver and Bronze medals, are given to Champions. Based on excellence, the demonstration of Competitors' skills attracts thousands of visitors at every edition. In addition to the Competitors' high level of skills, the value of excellence is illustrated because of the unique opportunity offered to all the countries that participate, to benchmark their vocational education and training systems, to challenge their traditional savoir-faire.

About WorldSkills Lyon 2024

WorldSkills Lyon 2024 is the Organizing Committee in charge of preparing and delivering the WorldSkills Competition in Lyon in September 2024. Key stakeholder within the French society when it comes to skills, it brings together all regional and national, private, public and civil society involved.

In 2024, the city of Lyon will be delighted to welcome 1,500 Competitors coming from 65 countries and regions who will compete in 62 skills, in front of 250,000 visitors, to demonstrate their excellence and savoir-faire.

More than just a Competition, WorldSkills Lyon 2024 is a portfolio of events designed to mobilize all skills and vocational training stakeholders in France and worldwide around our values of Openness, Generosity, Unity and Excellence.

WorldSkills commitment toward Education and young people

One of WorldSkills Lyon 2024 first goals, is to fight prejudice towards vocational training and skills, while inspiring the next generation of young talents. Thus, an ambitious programme had been designed towards young people in order to raise awareness when it comes to skills. Among the 250,000 visitors, half of them will be students and pupils.

Before the Competition, local school will be partnered with a Member country or region to learn about their culture, traditions, and customs, while highlighting the skills which will be represented at the Competition by the Competitors.

During the Competition, an immersive visitor experience and specifics programme will be designed for them so they can have a fair, lively and dynamic image of today's professions.
